In order to successfully submit your work, you are kindly requested to follow the guidelines below.

### Important Date

**Abstract Submission Deadline: January 20, 2026**

### How to Submit an Abstract

#### Abstract Topics

All abstracts must be allocated to a specific Topic. For a complete listing of abstract Topics, see below:

1. Carotid disease
2. Peripheral obstructive arterial disease
3. Aneurysms in the Thoracic / Abdominal Aorta
4. Peripheral aneurysms
5. Vascular trauma
6. Aortic Dissection and Branch Vessels
7. Vein diseases
8. Thromboembolic Disease
9. Vascular accesses in kidney patients
10. Vascular ultrasound
11. Pathophysiology of vascular diseases
12. Angiogenesis
13. New anticoagulants
14. Antiplatelet medicines

**Note:** Although the Committee will work hard to honor this selection, this cannot be guaranteed. The Committee reserves the right to change the Topic under which the abstract was originally submitted.



### Abstract Format

All abstracts should be submitted in Word format.

### Abstract Title

Indicate the title of your abstract.

### Authors

- Include the authors and the affiliation details  
**(Department, University/Institute, City, Country).**
- Indicate the presenting author by underlining his name.
- Include the Presenting author's contact details  
**(Full first and family name(s), email address, phone number).**

### Abstract Layout

Use the following structured format in the final version of your abstract.

*Introduction – Methods – Results – Conclusions*

### Abstract Text

- The abstract title should not exceed the limit of **25 words**. Write the title of the abstract avoiding the use of non-standard abbreviations in capital letters.
- The abstract body should not exceed the limit of **350 words**, clear, concise, and written in English with correct spelling and good sentence structure.

### Table(s)

- Tables/diagrams/pictures should be included as an image file (jpeg, gif etc). Use of such graphics will reduce the number of words allowed (each of them should correspond to 50 words and must be included in the limitation of 350 words in order to fit the size of an A4 paper).
- A maximum of two (2) images can be included per abstract. The image(s) will be placed at the bottom of the abstract in all publications and may be resized to fit in the format of the final printed material.

### Abstract Submission

### **Abstract Submission Deadline: 20 January 2026**

Abstracts must be received by the announced deadline. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered.

Acknowledgement of receipt of the abstract submission will be sent to the corresponding author. If you do not receive the confirmatory e-mail within 24 hours, please contact the Congress Secretariat at [abstracts@conferre.gr](mailto:abstracts@conferre.gr)

The corresponding author will receive all correspondence concerning the abstract and is responsible for informing co-authors of the status of the submitted abstract.

Upon submission by email, please indicate a preferred type of presentation and the Abstract topic.

- Oral Presentation

### **Abstract Selection and Presentation**

The Scientific Committee will review all submitted abstracts and determine whether the abstract will be accepted for presentation. The type of presentation will also be determined by the Committee, with consideration given to the author's preference. The corresponding author will be notified with reference to the approval or rejection of the submitted abstract(s) **by email.**

### **Publication**

All abstracts accepted as Oral Presentations or e-Posters, will be published in the Official Congress **Abstract Book.**
